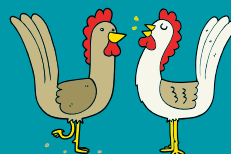
YEAR 6 GREEFF ASSEMBLY

Cyber-Safety

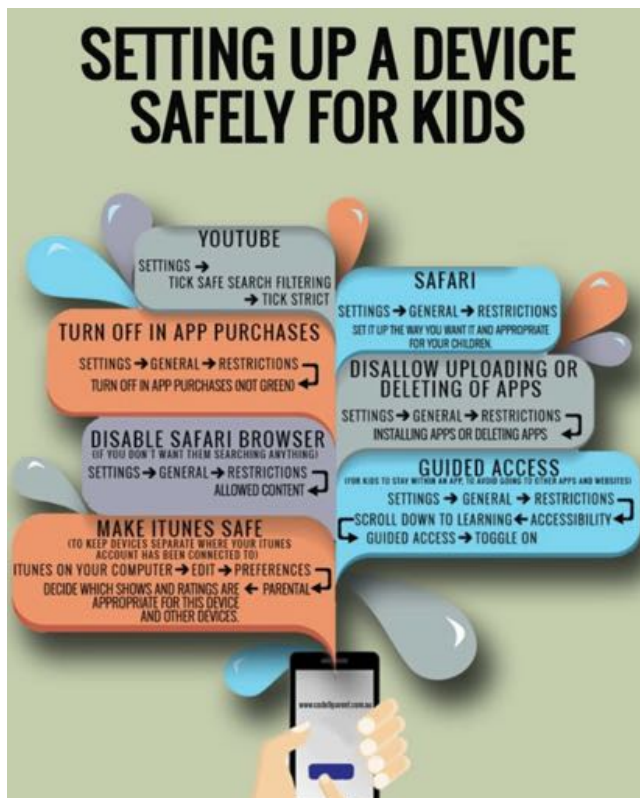

I've spent a few sessions with some of our students exploring the new Court Grammar School Careers Website ([cgscareers.com](https://www.cgscareers.com)) and I must give full credit to our Careers Advisor and VET Coordinator Mrs Marie McGinnis who has done an excellent job of arranging this for us.

The website is linked through the SEQTA Learn front page. A page I've spent a lot of time on with the students is the Investigate a Job page ([https://www.cgscareers.com/?page=job-and-career-search\(2\)](https://www.cgscareers.com/?page=job-and-career-search(2))), as this provides a lot of very useful information that is relevant to what the students want to know, such as:

Weekly pay

Employment size (how many people are currently employed in this job)

Future growth (is this job likely to be replaced by Artificial Intelligence – or not!)

Skill level (what level of specialisation do you need to do this job?)

Unemployment (are there a lot of people, trained in this industry, who currently do not have a job in this role)

Full-Time Share (what percentage of those working in this job are actually working full-time)

Average age (of those employed)

And more

The website lists over 600 jobs and that in itself can be a process of exploration. The job front and industry markets are constantly changing and we can't assume the jobs our parents do/did will still be there in the future. This is an excellent resource for future-proofing your potential career path.

Invitation to Parents

On Tuesday 28 May we will be running a series of workshops for students, staff and parents on the topic of Cyber safety.

Throughout the day we will be running a series of workshops for students in Years 4–10 which will be tailored to their developmental needs. Following the students' sessions, ALL teaching staff will also participate in a workshop. Finally, we will finish the day with a session for PARENTS. This session will commence at 6.30pm.

The parent Cyber Safety session has been developed with an appreciation of the complexities of parenting in the digital age, we provide parents with realistic, digestible, and engaging cyber safety education sessions. Filled with real-world and relevant information, these sessions provide strategy-rich and practical content that can be implemented immediately to promote safer online environments. Topics covered include social media, understanding cyber safety risks and strategies for online behaviour management.

At the end of each session, all attendees are provided with access to our follow-up resource 'A Parent's Guide to Setting Up A Cyber Safe Home'

The provider of the workshops is an organisation called YSafe. Originally founded by psychologists, the team expanded to include clinical psychologists, law enforcement experts and educators who specialise in cyber safety and social media. Their combined experience in child development, research, policing, and classroom contexts provides a unique insight into the challenges and opportunities that participating in a digital environment presents to students, parents, and schools.
