- **Inclusive Environment:** We embrace diversity and are dedicated to providing culturally safe spaces for all students.
- **Empowerment and Voice:** We listen to our students and actively involve them in decisions that affect their lives and safety.

Our Action Plan

To ensure a proactive safety culture, we commit to the following everyday practices:

1. **Rigorous Staff Vetting:** Ensuring all staff and volunteers undergo strict background checks, screening and participate in the induction process.
2. **Duty of Care:** Training all employees to recognize signs of harm, respond promptly, and refer concerns to appropriate support systems.
3. **Open Communication:** Fostering strong partnerships with families and the wider community so safety remains a shared responsibility.
4. **Safety Education:** Equipping students with safety and wellbeing knowledge; and confidence to speak up if they feel unsafe or threatened.
5. **Policies and Procedures:** Embedding the 'National Principles for Child Safety' in the development and implementation of our policies, programs, projects and practices.
