TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following terms and conditions apply with regard to the application for and acceptance of a Scholarship:

- i) Applicants must first be successful in gaining a placement at the School before being eligible for a scholarship or bursary.
- ii) Applicants must meet the requirements of the scholarship or bursary for which they are applying.
- iii) The applicant has included the following with their application
 - a. Previous school reports (last 2 years) – external students only
 - b. Most recent NAPLAN results – external students only
 - c. Any other supporting documentation
 - d. Application fee \$100 (per Academic and New Student Scholarship)
- iv) Successful application does in no way bind the School to granting a scholarship to younger siblings in later years. It is to be noted that younger siblings enrolled at Court Grammar School receive normal family discounts.
- v) Failure to meet satisfactory standards of achievement may result in the Scholarship or Bursary being withdrawn.
- vi) Failure of the successful applicant or his/her parents to adhere to the conditions of enrolment, ie: ensuring that the student wears the full school uniform, upholding the published rules of the school, supporting the Christian philosophy of the School, and participating in School activities, may result in the Scholarship or Bursary being withdrawn.
- vii) Applicants cannot hold more than one scholarship/bursary at any given time. In the instance where an applicant is awarded a scholarship/bursary and already holds one, the higher value scholarship/bursary will apply.
